GENERAL RULES FOR MAINTAINANCE OF DISCIPLINE IN COLLEGE

1. Ragging is strictly prohibited. Strong disciplinary action will be taken if one is found to be involved directly or indirectly in ragging.
2. Students must wear uniforms while entering college. No student is allowed to enter the classroom without proper and prescribed uniform.
3. Chewing tobacco, pan masala, gutkha and consuming any kind of intoxicating substances etc. inside the campus is strictly prohibited.
4. Littering of any kind in college campus or in the classroom is strictly prohibited.
5. Any kind of unlawful/unethical acts conducted by the students will meet with strict action.
6. Any kind of damage to the college property will be taken seriously and strict action will be taken accordingly.
7. Any notice desired to be pasted or circulated by the students anywhere in the college premises will need prior permission from the college authority.
8. Use of mobile phone, motorcycle and car by the students inside the college campus is strictly prohibited.
9. 75% attendance is compulsory for all the students.
10. Any unfair means adopted in the examination will lead to the extent of expulsion without compromise.
11. Violations of rules, showing discourtesy towards teachers and staff members in any form, delinquent behaviour inside the college campus may invite disciplinary action like termination of scholarship, forced transfer and even expulsion from the college.
12. Students must abide by all rules and regulations as prescribed by the college authorities.
13. Maintenance of discipline is vested with the head of the institution. His/her decision shall be final in all such matters.
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RULES AND REGULATIONS OF LIBRARY

1. The library remains open from 9.00AM to 4.30PM on all working days.
2. Only registered members are allowed to avail the library facilities.
3. On entry members are required to produce valid ID-card issued by the college authority.
4. Students can borrow books against their library cards. Books are normally issued for a period of 10 days. After the stipulated time period @Rs. 1/- per day will be charged.
5. Library card are not transferable. Borrowers are responsible for the books issued against library card if lost.
6. Students should not write in, mark or otherwise disfigure or damage books. In such case the cost of articles shall have to be paid by the member.
7. Readers should observe 'SILENCE' in the library reading room.
